The European Carton Excellence Awards is celebrating its 25th anniversary and is now accepting entries for 2021

2021 marks an incredible milestone for the European Carton Excellence Awards, celebrating 25 years of innovation in the cartonboard industry. Submissions to Europe's most prestigious annual carton award scheme hosted by Pro Carton and the European Carton Makers Associations (ECMA) are now open, for what is expected to be the most impressive awards yet.



For the past quarter-century, the awards have challenged partners from all levels within the supply chain to showcase the best cartonboard packaging designs. In 2020, disruption brought about by the global COVID-19 pandemic did not stop the industry's creativity. The Carton of the Year title went to *Van Genechten Packaging* and *Stora Enso* for their beautiful Roku Gin entry, which perfectly conveyed the product's story through luxurious embossing and Japanese floral print.

2020 Save the Planer winner: Eco Fit Lid

The Save the planet award went to Seda's Eco Fit lid as adopted by McDonald's whilst the Innovation Award was won by Snel's Re-Fruiter Tray, which not only has built-in feet that raise the pack but a patented angled die-cut profile that forms a flexible base. The public award went to Graphic Packaging's KeelClipTM, which is being used by brands ranging from Coca-Cola to Budweiser.

What is cartonboard?

Cartonboard is a multilayer paper-based material with, usually, three or more layers of fibre derived from wood, or recycled materials such as paper or cartonboard. It is often used in packaging to make cartons for everyday products, such as breakfast cereals, frozen foods, luxury fragrances and pharmaceuticals.

Is cartonboard the same as cardboard?

Cardboard is a generic term and, whilst cartonboard is a type of cardboard, it is different from 'corrugated cardboard' which is a firmer, heavy-duty paper-based packaging commonly used for transport (like Amazon parcels). In contrast, Cartons are always printed often with high quality graphics and special varnishes and finishes. Liquid packaging board (e.g. Tetra Pak) used to hold milk and fruit juice is not categorised as cartonboard.
